Dear Distributor

As a reminder, if you or anyone from your organization is planning to visit Lebanon, please note the following important travel restrictions:

1. Israeli passports will not be accepted for entry into Lebanon
2. Foreign Passports will not be accepted for entry into Lebanon if they contain stamps that confirm or validate an entry into Israel
3. Foreign Passports will not be accepted for entry into Lebanon if they contain stamps from any crossing border points with Israel. This includes the Arabia border, Sheikh Hussein border, Rafah border, and Taba border.

In addition, any person entering Lebanon must hold a passport, which is valid for a period of at least six months and an appropriate visa, the letter issued at the Lebanese [Embassies and Consulates abroad](#), or by the [Directorate General of Security](#) at the Lebanese border or airport. The citizens of some states are given a direct three-month renewable multiple-entry visa. Visitors should contact their local Lebanon Embassy or Ministry of Foreign Affairs for further specific details.
